**1. Foundations of Growth Management Planning: King County Planning Policies and Process**

Karen Wolf, King County Senior Policy Analyst, gave a presentation regarding King County policies and processes, including multi-county policies related to growth and Vision 2040. Ms. Wolf said that the County has begun work on Vision 2050 using information gathered from local cities' 2015 Comprehensive Plans. Ms. Wolf then answered questions from Council.

**2. Foundations of Growth Management Planning: METRO Transit Planning, Forecasting in METRO CONNECTS and METRO CONNECTS Implementation Plan**

Graydon Newman, King County Transportation Planner III, gave a presentation regarding METRO CONNECTS, a long-range vision plan related to transit in the region. Mr. Newman reviewed the vision for 2025 and 2040 and the process Metro went through to develop the vision plan. Mr. Newman then answered questions from Council.
