Outstanding Community Service Award

The “Outstanding Community Service Award”, previously known as the “Volunteer of the Year Award”, is for the purpose of honoring an adult individual, youth individual and organization who are making impactful contributions to Duvall and the lower Snoqualmie Valley through dedication of time, talents, dedication and actions. The successful honorees should serve as role models for service and compassion, and strive to make Duvall a better place through their efforts.

Eligibility:

Any adult individual, youth individual or organization (business, school, non-profit organization, etc.) who lives or is based in Duvall (encompassing the 98019 zip code) and conducts eligible service activities that benefit the residents of Duvall are eligible for nomination and award.

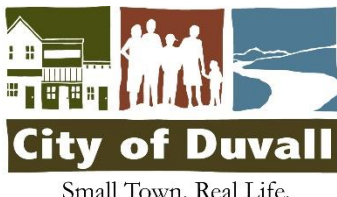
Criteria:

Nominees will have demonstrated qualities of service and compassion in our community through an organization or volunteer activities in the preceding calendar year. The Nominees will not have received any monetary or personal benefits from their involvement. Nominees must reside or have a business within Duvall city limits or the 98019 zip code.

Judging Criteria:

- The degree to which their services/actions have made a lasting or meaningful contribution or impact on the community;
- The length and degree of their service;
- The extent to which their service might be considered above and beyond the call of duty;
- The extent to which their action would be recognized and valued by their peers/community leaders;
- Nominee may be considered a mentor to others based upon their volunteer efforts.
