### **Duvall City Council is considering a Fireworks Emergency Ban Provision Ordinance**

**Summary:** This is an ordinance that would grant the City of Duvall Mayor the authority, with recommendation from the Fire Chief, to ban fireworks temporarily in cases of extreme fire danger or other relevant factors.

This is not an ordinance to ban fireworks all-together.
