**RE: Temporary Halt to the Acceptance and Issuing of Special Event Permits**

Effective April 3, 2020 the City will halt accepting and processing all special events permits that are not deemed necessary by the Governor's "Stay Home, Stay Healthy" order, which has been extended through May 4, 2020.

We regret that this needs to occur, however it is for the health and safety of our community and employees. We all need to do our part to flatten the curve and abide by the formal orders that are currently in place.

This policy will be re-evaluated upon the rescinding of the Governor's order, and any subsequent orders specifying maximum group numbers for social and public gatherings.

At this time, we do not expect all restrictions to be removed until June at the earliest as a result of the rapidly changing nature of the pandemic situation.

Thank you for your patience during these trying times. I truly look forward to the day when we can once again gather together as a community and celebrate all that we have and share together.
