Implementation of Phase I Construction Restart – Proclamation 20-25

This bulletin serves as general information for our community; low-risk construction activities have now been allowed to resume.

On April 25, 2020 the Governor issued an addendum (memo) to Proclamation 20-25. The Governor's Memo rescinds previous guidance related to construction from the essential business list and allows for all construction activities capable of meeting a low-risk threshold and maintain six-feet of social distancing. The City is working with local developers and contractors on site-specific plans that ensure the safety of our workforce as well as theirs. Our community can expect to see a ramp up of activity at these sites over the coming week.
