



# Duvall Recycling Collection Event

Saturday, July 18, 2020 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.

## Here is what you can bring.....

*Please provide exact change for user fees.*



- **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per vehicle (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 for extra tires off rim. \$3.00 for each passenger tire on rim. \$9 charged for each large truck tire and \$18 charged for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted (**no charge**).
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell alkaline batteries. Rechargeable batteries and cell phone batteries also accepted (**no charge**).
- **NEW ITEM - Styrofoam Blocks and Packing Peanuts - This is a pilot project. White styrofoam blocks. Packing peanuts (any color). No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation. Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. Packing peanuts: please keep in box or bag. Materials must be clean and dry.**
- **NEW ITEM - MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS: Mattresses and box springs, any size. Fee: \$15 per mattress and \$15 per box spring. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.**
- **CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Limit 4 file-size boxes. No exceptions (**no charge**).
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. No furniture accepted. No items in need of repair will be accepted (**no charge**).
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$15 charge (cash only).**
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), appliances, metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, washers & dryers, dishwashers, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts, and sealed drums will not be accepted (**no charge - see exception above**).
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$30 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$35 will be charged for each household air conditioner (**cash only**). **Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.**
- **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers, computer monitors, mouse, and keyboards (**no charge**).
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).

**PLEASE NOTE: MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE will not be accepted. Please bring these materials to the roving Household Hazardous Wastemobile or the household hazardous waste collection site at Factoria Transfer Station (13800 S.E. 32nd St., Bellevue). The roving Wastemobile will visit the Carnation/Duvall area on August 14, 15, and 16 at the Tolt MacDonald Park - Boeing Mariner's Care Field (3600 Block of Tolt Ave). Hours are 10 am to 5 pm. Volume restrictions apply. Please segregate motor oil from all other fluids.**



**E-Cycle Washington**

Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit [1800recycle.wa.gov](http://1800recycle.wa.gov) to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. You may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions at no charge at the following location - NW Center Truck at Cottage Lake Safeway (19150 NE Woodinville Duvall Rd, Woodinville, WA 98077, 1-800-992-2060) and Goodwill Monroe Store (14751 Chain Lake Road SE, Monroe, WA 98272, 360-794-6834). Drop off locations may change. Quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Event. **Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.**

### These household wastes:

- NO concrete, brick, asphalt, etc.
- NO construction/demolition debris
- NO garbage
- NO furniture
- NO cardboard
- NO window glass
- NO yardwaste or scrap wood

### These hazardous wastes:

- NO MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE
- NO fluorescent lights
- NO oil based paint/solvents
- NO pesticides/herbicides
- NO solvents and thinners
- NO household chemicals
- NO cleaning products

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the WasteMobile or one of four household hazardous waste collection sites. **The WasteMobile will visit the Home Depot in Redmond July 17, 18, and 19 (17777 NE 76th St., Redmond). Hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. The WasteMobile will also visit the Carnation/Duvall area on August 14, 15, and 16 at the Tolt MacDonald Park - Boeing Mariner's Care Field (3600 Block of Tolt Ave). Hours are 10 am to 5 pm.** For additional WasteMobile dates and locations, visit: <https://www.hazwastehelp.org/HHW/disposal-locations.aspx>. Please segregate motor oil from all other fluids.

Please Note: Latex paint is not considered hazardous waste and the household hazardous waste facilities will not accept it. Latex paint should be dried out in the can then placed in the garbage with the lid off.
