1. IFIT-KC: Community Representative Advertising
 - a) Chief's message and additional information going out to the community in April utility billing and will be posted on the PD Facebook page and City website
 - b) Virtual information session with Acting Chief DeBock on April 12, 2021
 - c) Open application period April 14-21, 2021
 - d) Virtual interviews April 28-29, 2021
 - e) Final selections May 6, 2021
2. Police Officer Recruitment Update
 - a) Oral boards were done with two lateral candidates on March 3, 2021
 - b) One (1) lateral candidate was selected and moved into the background phase
 - c) Lateral candidate recently withdrew to pursue another opportunity while background was being completed
 - d) Lateral candidate was replaced with an entry level candidate, giving us two (2) entry level candidates currently in background
 - e) If all goes well, the first entry level candidate will begin academy training in May and graduate in September
 - f) If all goes well, the second entry level candidate (Chief Hert's position) will begin academy training in June and graduate in October
3. Side by Side/Jet Ski Proposal
 - a) We are anticipating McCormick Park and the beach to be very busy this summer
 - b) Water safety/patrol and crowd control in the park will be needed
 - c) Due to a manufacturing shortage, jet ski loaner program is not available in 2021
 - d) Side by Side would provide much easier access to the park and trails
 - e) Jet skis would provide the water safety presence to keep swimmers safe
 - f) We are proposing to use stimulus funds for these purchases, as we will need the presence in both areas, as COVID restrictions continue to loosen
 - e) A proposal has been submitted to Mayor Ockerlander for review
4. Phase 3 COVID-19 Transition
 - a) Police Department to remain closed to the public, at-this-time
 - b) Health screening, temperature check, and mask protocols remain in place
 - c) Police Administration transitioning back to the office two days per week
