1. IFIT-KC: Community Representative Update

2. Police Officer Recruitment Update
 - a) Officer Pa is progressing well through phase 1 of the FTO program
 - b) Recruit Dunklee has been accepted into BLEA Class 822; beginning on June 2nd
 - c) Looking for lateral candidate to fill final vacancy
 - d) We are participating in a virtual job fair through PST in June
3. Fireworks Ban Discussion
 - a) Met on 5/5 with Mayor Ockerlander, Mayor Pro-Tem Remington, Fire Chief Burke
 - b) Discussed KC Fireworks ban and what that means for the City
 - c) Mayor Ockerlander requested a short presentation from Police/Fire at COW
 - d) We have completed our portion which includes calls for service for last 3 years
 - e) Presentation was sent to FD45 for additional information
4. Water Safety Update
 - a) Lt. Sabourin reached out to WCIA regarding additional water safety signage at the beach
 - b) WCIA recommended wording about the strong current, cold water, and a reminder to parents about supervising their children
 - c) Memo from Police Administration for discussion
5. Police Duvall Days Plan
 - a) Much smaller event this year
 - b) Only one Officer will be needed on overtime which is reimbursed by the event
 - c) Bike Patrol and Police presence with traveling stage for traffic safety
 - d) Police presence at fireworks in the park
