### 1. Police Officer Recruitment/Hiring Update

- a) Officer Dean has successfully completed the FTO program
- b) Officer Dunklee is progressing well through the FTO program
- c) Elliott Head has been hired with an academy start date of March 8, 2022
- d) Jose Nunez has passed his background investigation and has been given a conditional offer of employment
- e) One (1) lateral candidate and one (1) exceptional entry candidate have passed their polygraph exams and we have started their background investigations
- f) Brandon Rhodes formally separated on 11/22/21
- g) Sgt. Warwick's last day with the department is 12/14/21

### 2. Reserve Officer MOU with Officers' Association (FOP)

- a) As discussed at council, ordinance with changes to DMC 4.04.020 "Hiring Process" and DMC 4.10.070 "Reserve Police Officers"
- b) MOU with FOP will solidify understanding of roles and circumstances surrounding paying Reserve Officers for certain duties
- c) Both parties have been notified and the MOU is currently being negotiated

### 3. Conflict Public Defender Services

- a) City has not traditionally had a contract for these services
- b) Would provide a flat fee for conflict services to supplement current indigent legal
- c) Valley Defenders was recommended by our City prosecutor
- d) DRAFT agreement has been reviewed by City attorney and recommended
- e) Plan is to bring to council at the 12/7 meeting

### 4. Jet Ski Procurement Update

- a) We received no bids after following the City procurement process
- b) We have reached out to a local dealer directly regarding price/availability
- c) We will likely be bringing a separate agenda bill to council regarding this, hopefully the 12/7 meeting
