

WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP OTHERS DURING THE HOLIDAYS?

"HOLIDAY HELPERS" -NOVEMBER 16TH - DECEMBER 7TH

The City of Duvall is partnering with Holy Innocents Outreach and Food Pantry this year for the holiday season, with support from the Duvall Chamber Of Commerce. This program helps people throughout the Snoqualmie Valley, and beyond, with food, personal care items, clothing year round, and gifts during the holidays. Their mission is "to provide service to all in need who come to seek aid". They never turn anyone away who asks for help and they are very much in need of our community's support during these difficult times.

How the "Holiday Helpers" program will work:

- -Beginning the week of November 16th through December 7th, visit a participating local retailer with a "Holiday Helpers" sign in their window and pick up a flyer outlining the items needed.
- -Purchase the items and leave them (unwrapped) with any participating retailer in their designated spot.
- -You may also choose to purchase a gift certificate from the retailer in lieu of choosing an item.
- Gift certificates and unwrapped items will be picked up and delivered to the outreach center for distribution.

Please do not drop off cash or other gift cards at the retail locations. Checks and gift cards from Target, Amazon, Visa, and Kroger (\$25 increments) are also being accepted, but must be mailed to Holy Innocents Catholic Church, P.O. Box 850, Duvall, WA 98019 or dropped off at the Church Office (26526 NE Cherry Valley Road, Duvall). The office is open Mon. – Thurs. from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Sunday 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Online monetary donations can also be made by visiting: https://www.holyinn.org.
