

Get your license: Concealed pistol license

Learn how to get your concealed pistol license (CPL) and see what fees are required.

License requirements

You must be 21 years old to get a CPL. You are required to have a CPL if you:

- Carry a pistol concealed on your person.
- Have a loaded pistol in your vehicle.

You won't qualify for a CPL if you:

- Have a revoked concealed pistol license.
- Are subject to a court order or injunction concerning the possession of firearms.
- Are free on bond or personal recognizance while awaiting trial, appeal, or sentencing for a felony offense.
- Have an outstanding warrant for your arrest for a felony or misdemeanor.
- Were ordered to forfeit a firearm within the last 12 months.
- Were convicted of a felony. To restore your rights, contact the courts where your conviction is or the superior court where you live.

How to apply

- Check the website [Duvall-City-Limits-2024](#) to verify you live in their jurisdiction. If so, ask for a Concealed Pistol License Application. If not call the King County Sheriff's Office 206-263-9133, or visit the [King County Sheriff's](#) website for details regarding these and other services.
- Fill out the application form [Concealed Pistol License Application](#)
- You will need a valid state driver license or ID with your current address on.
- If you are a permanent resident alien, bring your permanent resident card.
- If you have an alien firearms license, bring your original passport and US-issued alien number or admission number.
- If applicable, bring your original certificate of rehabilitation or firearms restoration orders.
- Pay licensing fees with check/money order payable to the "City of Duvall".
- Duvall PD will complete the fingerprints and a background check.

First Time License:

Step 1. Fill out an Original License Application. **DO NOT SIGN OR DATE YET**

Step 2. Bring in your filled out application, your driver's license (It MUST have your current Duvall address on it, must live within city limits) and a check or money order in the amount of \$44.00. Please make the check or money order out to "City of Duvall".

Step 3. When you bring in the application, drivers license, and payment, we will take your fingerprints. If you prefer to come back a different day to get your fingerprints done, please let us know and we can schedule a date and time for you.

Step 4. Once fingerprinting has been done, sign and date application.

Renewal Applications (up to 60 days before expiration date)

Step 1. Application filled out and signed.

Step 2. Bring in your filled out application, your driver's license (It MUST have your current Duvall address on it, must live within city limits) and a check or money order in the amount of \$32.00. Please make the check or money order out to "City of Duvall". Please be sure to bring your current CPL as well.

Late renewals (within 90 days after expiration date)

Step 1. Application filled out and signed.

Step 2. Bring in your filled out application, your driver's license (It MUST have your current Duvall address on it, must live within city limits) and a check or money order in the amount of \$42.00. Please make the check or money order out to "City of Duvall". Please be sure to bring your expired CPL as well.

License Replacement:

(Newly issued with same expiration date as original)

Step 1. Application filled out and signed.

Step 2. Bring in your filled out application, your driver's license (It MUST have your current Duvall address on it, must live within city limits) and a check or money order in the amount of \$10.00. Please make the check or money order out to "City of Duvall".
